Annex to IWALC Bulletin

May 2021

Introduction

This Annex summarises the results of the recent elections in each of the Island's 33 local parish, town and community councils. It includes both IWALC members (Part 1) and non-members (Part 2). The format of the entries is similar to that of the Annex to the April IWALC Bulletin.

The data

For each council, the following information is provided:

- number of wards;
- number of seats to be filled;
- number of candidates who stood in the election;
- number of contested wards (i.e. wards in which the number of candidates exceeded the number of seats and so a poll was held);
- number of unfilled seats (if any);
- number of new candidates (i.e. candidates who were not already councillors) standing;
- number of candidates new to that council (i.e. candidates who were already councillors but in a different council);
- number of new candidates who were actually elected; and
- number of candidates new to that council who were actually elected.

The names of all the newly elected councillors are also provided.

All the information was obtained from the election data published online by the Isle of Wight Council's Returning Officer – for details, see: https://www.iow.gov.uk/Council/Elections/Elections-Management/PCC-and-Local-Elections-May-2021.

Overview of the findings

For electoral purposes, the 33 local councils are divided into 66 wards. The number of wards per council varies significantly: 12 councils have only one ward while two (Newport & Carisbrooke and Ryde) have seven. The number of wards depends primarily on population but also on geography; for example, some of the smaller councils cover more than one village, each of which has its own ward.

The total number of seats available (i.e. the total number of councillors in the 33 councils) was 299 and coincidentally 300 candidates stood for election to those seats. This may look like an almost perfect fit, but in fact it was not because the relationship between seats and candidates varied significantly between councils and, within councils, from one ward to another. In 18 (27%) of the 66 wards, there were more than enough candidates, in 27 (41%), there were exactly the right number of candidates to fill the seats, and in 21 wards (32%) there were not enough candidates to fill all the seats. In the 18 wards where there were more than enough seats, a poll was held on 6 April, while in the other 48 wards (73% of the total) all the candidates who stood were elected unopposed.

The councils with the highest levels of competition for seats tended to be in urban areas. The highest were in Bembridge and Sandown, where all wards were contested, and in Ryde, where six of the seven wards were contested. In all three of these councils, there were 1.5 candidates for each seat. However, this level of competition was not found in all urban councils. Thus, in Newport & Carisbrooke, only one ward was contested and there were only 15 candidates contesting the 14 seats. The average turnout in these polls was 37%, with a range from 29% in East Cowes Osborne ward to 54% in Niton ward.

The 21 wards in which there not enough candidates to fill the seats were more evenly distributed between urban and rural councils. Eighteen (55%) of the 33 councils are affected. In total, 35 (12%) of the 299 seats were unfilled. In most councils, the shortfall was only one or two seats, but in one council it was six.

The 18 councils with unfilled seats will have to co-opt members to fill the gaps. In three councils (Nettlestone & Seaview, Rookley and Wroxall) more than a third of the councillors will be co-opted. This means that, although they will be able to operate legally, their powers will be somewhat limited because they will not be able to exercise the 'general power of competence' available to local councils under the 2011 Localism Act. In order to qualify for this power, at least two thirds of the members must be elected (either in a poll or uncontested) and the clerk must have a Certificate in Local Council Administration (CiLCA) or equivalent professional qualification.

The substantial number of unfilled seats suggests the need for more people to stand for election to local councils, at least in some council areas. Eighty-five (28%) of the 300 candidates were actually new candidates – that is, people not currently serving as councillors. There were some new candidates in 21 (66%) of the 33 councils. However, the number varied greatly, from one or two in most councils to 13 in one (Ryde). In three councils (Bembridge, Ryde and Sandown) over 50% of candidates were new.

Of the 85 new candidates, 71 (84%) were actually elected and thus become councillors. Thirty-one were elected unopposed and 40 through a poll. In most councils, the number of new councillors is small, but in three it is at least 50%. These are Sandown (50%), Bembridge (58%) and Ryde (63%).

Finally, it should be noted that there were also 13 candidates (4% of the total) who were already councillors but stood for election in a different council. This may happen if a councillor moves house, but more often it is because they are qualified to stand in more than one council area. Candidates can stand for a council if they live within three miles of the council boundary, if they work in the council area and/or if they own a property or business in the council area. These rules also enable someone to be a member of more than one council. Eleven (85%) of these 13 candidates were actually elected.


Of the 13 candidates who stood in a different council, ten (77%) were actually elected. Seven were elected unopposed and three through a poll.

Implications of the findings

What do these findings tell us about the quality of local democracy on the Island? The most obvious conclusion is that there are major variations between councils. However, further research is needed to understand the reasons for these variations and thus for their implications. It would be particularly interesting to know why there was so much variation in the amount of competition for seats and what motivated new candidates to stand. IWALC will seek to explore these and other questions over the next four years.
